TENNESSEE HOPE SCHOLARSHIP

- Award amount - \$2,250 for 4-year institutions for Years 1 and 2 and up to \$2,850 for Years 3 and 4; \$1600 for 2-year institutions (no more than cost of attendance)
- Entering freshmen (High School Class of 2005 and thereafter) must have a minimum of a 21 ACT (980 SAT) **OR** overall weighted minimum 3.0 grade point average (GPA) on the Tennessee Uniform Grading Scale. **This does not align to the WCS Grading Scale that is reflected on your child's transcript and report card.**
