Make videos, some on your own and some in small groups — interviews, news packages, short movies, and music videos. Work in video production teams to cover school events and studio programs.

TV & FILM 2

TDOE calls it AV Production 2. Course code is C11H02. TV & FILM 1 is a prerequisite for this course. A Teacher recommendation is required.

Become a video storyteller. Build advanced skills with recording equipment and editing software, including 'Adobe PhotoShop', ChromaKey, special effects, and more. Make advanced video content, some on your own and some leading video production teams — studio TV shows, short movies, music videos, and more. Work in teams to cover school events and studio programs.

TV & FILM 3

TDOE calls it AV Production 3. Course code is C11H03. TV & FILM 2 is a prerequisite for this course. A Teacher recommendation is required.

Lead the video program in developing program content, leading teams from other classes, and creating advanced video projects. Use advanced storytelling and recording skills to create programming for the school and the public. Learn basic 'Adobe After Effects' software. Make advanced video content, some on your own and some leading video production teams — studio TV shows, short movies, music videos, and more. Lead teams to cover school events and studio programs.

APPLIED ARTS PRACTICUM

TDOE calls it Applied Arts Practicum. Course code is C05H11. TV & FILM 3 is a prerequisite for this course. A Teacher recommendation is required.
