## **Senior Attendance for Exemptions**

- 1) Register for a Parent Portal account and log on to see your attendance.
- 2) Count the absence codes for each period. Remember if you are not in class for 10 or more minutes at any point during the period, you can be marked absent.
- 3) You must have Six (6) or fewer absence codes <u>per period</u>, <u>per semester</u> in order to be exempt AND have at least a 91 average in the class.
- 4) If you believe that an absence is not correct, review it <u>with your teacher</u> and have the teacher <u>email</u> Mrs. Everding to have it corrected. <u>Give these corrections overnight to show in Parent Portal.</u>
- 5) Teachers have the final say regarding attendance if you are border-line, you should double check with your teacher's attendance.
