

## WHO CAN I CALL IF I AM CONCERNED ABOUT MY CHILD'S DEVELOPMENT?

If your child is between the ages of 2.5 and 5 years and you are a resident of Williamson County Schools call **Student Support Services at (615) 472-4130**.

A child can be referred for **screening/evaluation** by school personnel, the family, and/or individuals in the community (physicians, childcare providers, etc.).

- A **screening/evaluation** checks to see if children are developing and learning the way they should be compared to same-age peers.
- **Screening** uses a variety of assessments and observations to identify concerns in a variety of areas.

## EARLY CHILDHOOD BLENDED PRESCHOOL PEER PROGRAM

Our Early Childhood (EC) program integrates students with disabilities and typically developing peer models (e.g. typical language, behavior, academic, and motor development). The early childhood classroom setting encourages play, movement, music and other developmentally appropriate activities to teach foundational skills.

- EC classes meet on **Monday, Tuesday, Thursday and Friday**, and follow a modified Williamson County Schools schedule. Children do not attend class on half days.
- The EC classrooms have 2 sessions each day, **8:50-11:50 AM** and **12:50-3:50 PM**. Some schools may have slight variations in time.
- Only residents in Williamson County School zones are eligible (regardless of your employment status with Williamson County Schools).
- You must be able to transport your child to/from school as EC peers are not eligible for WCS bus services.
