What to Expect in AP Human Geography Boot Camp:

- Connections, connections, connections...it's all about the BIG PICTURE! We will look at current events and connect them to basic geography terms.
- > Preview the readings (textbook) and prepare you for the vocabulary and content.
- Discuss the breakdown of test questions, practice with Multiple Choice and identify the elements of how to answer FRQ's (Free-Response Questions).
- Work on developing skills & setting expectations for notetaking, reading, time management, and work ethic.

What to Expect in AP Human Geography:

AP Human Geography is a yearlong course that focuses on the distribution, processes, and effects of human populations on the planet. During the course of the year, you will learn the basics of geography, population and migration issues, cultural patterns (languages, religions, and ethnicities), geopolitical issues, agriculture and food production, industrial development, urban growth and environmental concerns. These topics are woven together as we will examine how one impacts the other.

All AP courses are college level and require college level work, effort, maturity, and discipline. All AP courses conclude with a national exam that is administered by The College Board in the spring.
