Tennessee State Law and the WCBOE have identified other zero tolerance offenses that, depending on the individual circumstances, may warrant "reasoned judgement" by the Principal in assigning punishment. These offenses may result in suspensions and placement at the WCS Alternative Learning Center (ALC) ranging from 20 days to 1 Calendar Year based upon the circumstances and other factors in each case.

On a case by case basis the Director of Schools may modify the one year suspension. Level 4 Offenses could result in Expulsion from WCS.
