WCBOE - Code of Conduct - Misbehaviors Level 1

RHS - AFTER SCHOOL DETENTION - Administrators Have Discretion to Assign Multiple Detentions for Level 1 Infractions

Level 1 offenses will result in After School Detention. Multiple Level 1 Infractions could result in Level 2 or 3 Consequences

*Administrators have discretion to issue verbal reprimands, restrict school privileges, and refer students for counseling, mediation or restorative conferences for Level 1 Infractions

Chromebooks	Failure to bring charged Chromebook to school will result in detention after 2nd offense
Conduct at School	Inappropriate behavior in classrooms, café, assemblies, hallways, bathrooms, parking lots, school grounds, buses
Disrespect	Inappropriate behavior or actions toward another student at school or on school grounds
Dress Code	No Hats, Proper Top Attire, Skirts and Shorts Proper Length - Wearing Clothing in an indecent manner that disrupts the learning environment
Technology	Misuse of Cell Phones and Computers/Chromebooks
Cheating and Lying	Violations of the RHS Academic Honor Code / Being Dishonest with RHS Faculty or Staff
Non-Defiant Behavior	Failure to do assignments or carry out directions
PDA	Public Displays of Affection that create a scene or draw undue attention
Tardies	Late Arrival to School (Less than 10 Minutes) or Late to Class - Teachers will assign detention for Tardies to Class

WCBOE - Code of Conduct - Misbehaviors Level 2

RHS - FRIDAY SCHOOL - Administrators Have Discretion to Assign Multiple Friday Schools for Level 2 Infractions

Level 2 offenses will result in Friday School. Multiple Level 2 Infractions could result in Level 3 or 4 Consequences

*Administrators have discretion to suspend students from school sponsored activities or WCS Buses for Level 2 Infractions.

*Administrators have discretion to refer students for mediation or restorative conferences for Level 2 Infractions.

Conduct at School	Inappropriate behavior in classrooms, café, assemblies, hallways, bathrooms, parking lots, school grounds, buses
False Documents	Submitting Forged Notes or Excuses to RHS Faculty and Staff
False Reports	Reporting False Information to RHS Faculty/Staff, Law Enforcement, or Emergency Entities During School Hours or at School Sponsored Activities
Disrespect	Inappropriate behavior or actions toward another student or teacher at school or on school grounds
Profanity/Vulgarity	Profane Language or Gestures (Verbal or Hand Signs) Clothing or Objects with Profane, Vulgar, Illegal or Offensive Images
Defiant Behavior	Failure to do assignments or carry out directions
Un-Excused Absences	Excessive Absences from Specific Classes or Excessive Absences From School
Entrance/Exit Doors	Propping Doors, Allowing Others Entry, Using Incorrect Entrance/Exit Doors, Trespassing Unsupervised In Building After School Hours.
School Parking Lots	Speeding, Wreckless Driving or Dangerous Activity in a vehicle. Students are prohibited from parking in the Faculty Parking Lot during school hours. All other parking lots are open to all students. Students must park in an un-numbered space. No Parking on Curbs or Grass Islands.
Skiping Class	Failure to report to any class, or missing more than 10 minutes of any class (Includes Study Hall, Homeroom/Lunch)

WCBOE - Code of Conduct - Misbehaviors Level 3**RHS - IN SCHOOL SUSPENSION (1 to 10 Days) / OUT OF SCHOOL SUSPENSION (1 to 10 Days)**

Level 3 offenses will result in In School Suspension (ISS). Administrators have discretion to assign between 1-10 days of ISS based on severity and frequency of Level 3 Infractions. Administration may also assign Out of School (OSS) for infractions. Multiple Level 3 Infractions could result in Level 4 Consequences.

*Administrators have discretion to refer students for mediation or restorative conferences for Level 3 Infractions.

Disrespect	Disrespect to any RHS Staff Member
Insubordination	Refusal to promptly comply with directions from any RHS staff member
Racial or Ethnic Slurs	Verbal, Written or Electronic use of Racially offensive/degrading terms or images. Mandatory 10 Days of ISS (Early Release possible - 7 Days) Offender will Submit a Written Assignment on Racism - Possible Restorative Conference with Victim
Harassment	Physical, Verbal, Cyber, Sexual, Racial, Ethnic, Religious (Repeated incidents of Harassment could result in level 4 Consequences)
Bullying	Physical, Verbal, Electronic, Cyber, or Social Victimization / Intimidation. (Repeated incidents of Bullying could result in level 4 Consequences)
Profanity/Vulgarity	Profane Language or Gestures (Verbal or Hand Signs) Clothing or Objects with Profane, Vulgar, Illegal or Offensive Images
Threats	Statements that imply intent to inflict pain, injury, damage or other hostile actions on another student
False Reports	Reporting False Information to RHS Faculty/Staff, Law Enforcement, or Emergency Entities During School Hours or at School Sponsored Activities
Physical Altercations	Punches, Shoving, Wrestling, Pantsing, Rough Horseplay that may cause bodily injury or emotional distress.
Nude Images	Accessing or Exposing - WCS HR and SRO Contacted. Transmission of inappropriate or unlawful - Contact WCS HR for Title IX, DCS Report & SRO Report
Technology	Use of Computers/Phones to Harass/Threaten others or Transmit Inappropriate Digital Images
Theft	Possession, Handling, or Sale of Stolen Materials - Administrators have discretion to require restitution for lost, damaged or stolen property.
Inappropriate Objects	Sexually, Racially, Religiously Offensive Objects or Possessing Replicas of Weapons (Fake Knives/Firearms - Includes Water Guns) (Possession of Replica Weapons that appear authentic could result in Level 4 Consequences)
Vandalism	Damaging WCS School Property or Others Property while on WCS School Grounds or School Sponsored Activities
Vaping/Tobacco	Possession, Handling, Use on WCS School Grounds or School Sponsored Activities (Defined In T.C.A. §49-6-4202(3)). Includes Accessories and other products/paraphernalia used for Vaping or Smoking Tobacco (Students Under 18 Will Receive a Tobacco Citation)

WCBOE - Code of Conduct - Misbehaviors Level 4**RHS - ZERO TOLERANCE OFFENSES (Reasoned Judgement)**

Level 4 offenses will result in placement at the ALC. Tennessee State Law and the WCBOE have identified other zero tolerance offenses that, depending on the individual circumstances, may warrant "reasoned judgement" by the Principal in assigning punishment. These offenses may result in suspensions and placement at the WCS Alternative Learning Center (ALC) ranging from 20 days to 1 Calendar Year based upon the circumstances and other factors in each case.

On a case by case basis the Director of Schools may modify the one year suspension. Level 4 Offenses could result in Expulsion from WCS.

*Administrators have discretion to refer students for mediation or restorative conferences for Level 4 Infractions.

Unruly Behavior	Continuation of Level 1, 2, and 3 Behaviors. (Reasoned Judgement) Unruly Petition Filed with the Juvenile Court of Williamson County
Assault	Fighting or Physical assault on another student on WCS School Grounds or School Sponsored Activities. (Reasoned Judgement)
Harmful Instruments	Possession or Handling of with intent to harm ones self or others on WCS Grounds or School Sponsored Activities Harmful Instruments other than Firearms (ex.) Pencil, Knife, Scissors, Razor, Compass, Sharp Tools, Objects used for blunt force.(Reasoned Judgement)
Substances	Possession, Handling or Use on WCS Grounds or School Sponsored Activities Substances (ex.) Non Scheduled or Non Prescription Medication, Chemicals, Inhalants, Non Regulated Vaping Substances. (Reasoned Judgement)
Harassment	Repeated Incidents of Physical, Verbal, Cyber, Sexual, Racial, Ethnic, or Religious Harassment. (Reasoned Judgement)
Bullying	Repeated Incidents of Physical, Verbal, Electronic, Cyber, or Social Victimization / Intimidation. (Reasoned Judgement)
Hit List	Compiling a List of Names with the Threat of doing bodily harm or causing death. (Reasoned Judgement)
Bomb Threat	Threatening to detonate an explosive device or an incendiary device to cause damage, injuries or death on WCS School Grounds or School Sponsored Activities. (Reasoned Judgement)
Threats of Mass Violence	Threatening to do bodily harm or death to (2) or more persons.
Arson	Intentionally setting fire to property on WCS School Grounds or School Sponsored Activities. (Reasoned Judgement)
Theft	Possession, Handling, or Sale of Stolen Materials - Administrators have discretion to require restitution for lost, damaged or stolen property. (Reasoned Judgement)
Extortion	Obtaining something, especially money, through force or threats. (Reasoned Judgement)
Alcohol	Possession, Handling, Use, Under the Influence of on WCS School Grounds or School Sponsored Activities
Assault on WCS Staff	Physical, Verbal or Electronic Threat on a WCS Employee or School Resource officer on WCS School Grounds or School Sponsored Activities
Aggravated Assault	Intentional or Wrecklessly causing bodily injury to another person. Intentional or Wreckless use or display of a deadly weapon on School Grounds or School Sponsored Activities
Drugs	Possession, Handling, Use, Under the Influence of on WCS School Grounds or School Sponsored Activities Drugs Defined - Any Controlled Substance - Marijuana, THC, Prescription Medication, Government Regulated Substances
Drug Paraphernalia	Possession, Handling, Use on WCS School Grounds or School Sponsored Activities (Defined In T.C.A. §49-6-4202(3)).
Weapons	Possession, Handling, Use on WCS School Grounds or School Sponsored Activities
