Woodland Middle School Discipline Plan

In order to maintain an environment that is conducive to effective teaching and learning, all students are expected to be respectful, responsible, safe and kind. When students are observed not meeting these expectations, we will follow the discipline plan outlined below.

- <u>Teachers will issue strikes to students for minor behaviors via</u>
 <u>a Google Form using the Discipline Rubric below as a</u>

 <u>reference</u>
- Strikes will reset every 2 weeks.
- Students who accumulate 5 strikes within a 2-week period will be assigned after school detention.
- Any teacher who issues 3 strikes to an individual student during a 2-week period must make a parent contact.
- The "Strike System" is intended to be utilized for minor infractions (see Discipline Rubric below)
- Consistency throughout the building is key
- Students receiving 10 or more strikes in a 2-week period will be placed on an excessive progression with different consequences.
- After the 3rd detention of a semester, each additional detention will be a Saturday school.

(Zero Tolerance Offenses)

Possession of drugs or alcohol, including any controlled substance, controlled substance analogue, or legend drug on school grounds or at a school-sponsored event

Aggravated assault

Assault that results in bodily injury upon any teacher, principal, administrator, any other employee of the school, or school resource officer

1st Offense:

Administrator contacts parent, issues out-of-school suspension, and contacts SRO
